

Dear Parents/Carers

Given that many students will have had a growth spurt since September, or may have already worn out items of their uniform /lost equipment it might be a timely opportunity to remind you of uniform and equipment expectations. Details can be found on our website or leaflets are available at reception throughout the year.

**Uniform:**

- School blazer: navy with school logo
- Smart, plain black trousers: full length, no zips, branding or clingy fabric
- Or smart, black, knee length skirt: no zips, branding or clingy fabric
- White shirt: suitable for a tie
- Navy blue V-neck jumper
- School tie: burgundy with white stripes
- Plain black tights or plain black or grey socks
- Black smart shoes: leather or 'leather look' (practical for wearing all day and in poor weather). No trainers or daps.
- Coats must be a dark colour and worn over the blazer. No hoodies.

For reasons of health and safety and to protect against loss of valuable property: No rings or jewellery should be worn except a watch. Students with pierced ears may wear one simple plain stud. No facial jewellery is accepted, including tongue studs. Inappropriate jewellery will be confiscated. Extremes of fashion in clothing, hairstyles or hair colours are not acceptable. If worn, make-up must be discreet.
